DAY 8 (NOV 28TH)


Today we visit Hebron and the Monastery of the Holy Trinity where Abraham was hospitable to the Three Angels.

DAY 1 (NOV 21ST)

Meet up at the airport in Tel Aviv with the pilgrims arriving from different parts of the world. We will get settled into our hotel rooms and enjoy dinner together.

DAY 2 (NOV 22ND)

A most spiritually exciting day in the Old City of Jerusalem: First of all we will bend our knee before the All-Holy Tomb of Christ. We will venerate Golgotha where our Christ was crucified, the anointing stone, the Chapel of the Finding of the Cross, Via Dolorosa, the Praetorius, the Apostle Peter's Prison, the Birthplace of the Theotokos, the Sheep's Pool Bethesda, the Convent of the Great Theotokos, the Tomb of the Most Holy Theotokos.

DAY 3 (NOV 23RD)

In the morning, we leave for the Jordan River to perform the blessing of the waters. Later, we will visit the Monastery of St. Gerasimos of the Jordan. Evening meal in our hotel and time to stroll the Old City.

DAY 4 (NOV 24TH)

We leave early in the morning to the monasteries of Hozeva, Sarantarion (Temptation of Christ), and the Prophet Elisha and the Sycamore Tree. We will also visit the Convent of Martha and Mary, and the Tomb of St.

Lazarus

DAY 5 (NOV 25TH)

We will ascend by our bus the Mount of Olives. We will kneel to venerate the place where the Lord left His footprint leaving to sit at the right hand of he Father. We will visit the Monastery of "Little Galilee where Christ twice appeared to His Apostles after the Resurrection and Mount Sion where the Mystical Supper and Pentecost took place. We continue on the Monasteries of the Holy Cross, Gorny, Katamonas (Tomb of St. Symeon the God-bearer), Mount Sion, the place of the House of St. John the Theologian where the Theotokos fell asleep and finally to the Well of Jacob.

DAY 6 (NOV 26TH)

Full day trip to the area of Galilee in Northern Israel. Christ spent most of His earthly days in Galilee and so we have much to venerate in this area. We will ascend by taxi to the top of Mount Tabor where the Holy Transfiguration took place. Then on to the city of Nazareth where the Annunciation to the Theotokos was made. We will visit Cana where Christ performed His first public miracle turning the water into wine at the request of His Mother. We will venerate the Monastery of the Holy Apostles at Capernaum where Christ and His Apostles spent most of their time. As all the other days, lunch will take place along the way. Then on to the Jordan River for the blessing of the waters and the symbolic baptism of the faithful. We return to our hotel for dinner and many things to talk about.
